North Development Levels Brass (2018 / 2017), Aluminium (2017 / 2016), Platinum (2016 / 2015)

Please note: Gymnasts born in 2017 (7yrs) may also enter the Tin or Zinc competitions and those born in 2016 (8yrs) who are working at the higher level will be able to enter Copper or Copper Plus levels at the coaches discretion.

Also: Any previous FIG gymnast who did not compete in the British Championships 2024 may enter **either** FIG or age relative classic challenge competitions.

Awards

Individual apparatus, and All Around medals and ribbons will be awarded in each age group outlined above (1st-6th place)

We will also have Artistry awards given out to gymnasts who particularly excel with their choreography on the Floor and/or Beam.

All gymnasts will receive a participation gift.

Competition Entry

A fee of £35 per gymnast is payable on entry. All entries should be received on the correct Pink Ladies Entry form which can be found via the website. Entry forms should be sent directly to the competition organiser kelly@southdurhamgym.co.uk and will be processed on receipt of the full entry fee.

LATE ENTRIES MAY BE ACCEPTED AT THE DISCRETION OF THE COMPETITION ORGANISER BUT THE ENTRY FEE WILL BE DOUBLED.

Insurance

All coaches and gymnasts must be insured with British Gymnastics. It is the responsibility of the Club to ensure that this is the case and South Durham Gymnastics Club hold no responsibility if this is not adhered to.

Coaches must also ensure they are qualified to an appropriate level for the skills that their gymnasts are competing.

Judge Provision

All clubs entering the Pink Ladies Invitational 2024 are expected to provide at least one judge for each day they have gymnasts competing. Failure to provide a judge for each day will result in a £100 fine to be added to your entry fee whilst providing a club level judge only will incur a £50 fine.

Admission

All spectator tickets for the event must be purchased on arrival. Ticket prices will be issued ahead of the event.

Car Parking

Spennymoor Leisure Centre has it's own car park however as we anticipate a large number of guests across the competition weekend the onsite spaces may not be sufficient. We therefore recommend the use of on street parking in the surrounding areas.
