



Formally known as Musical.ly & Live.ly, TikTok is a free social media platform used to create and share short videos. TikTok rules require the user to be 13 or older to use it and with parental consent if you're under 18. Users are able to create videos of themselves lip-syncing that can last up to 60 seconds. You are able to watch other user's streams & videos, you may be exposed to inappropriate content.

Privacy


Set your account to private using these simple instructions;

- Tap on  in the bottom right corner of the app.
- Tap on  & then select Privacy & Safety.
- Switch 'Private Account' on. Configure who can **send you comments, duet with you** and **send you messages**.
- Your TikTok is now private!

Block

Block a user using these simple instructions;

- Go to the user you wish to report.
- Tap on 
- Tap on **Block** & then **Confirm**.



Report

Report a user using these simple instructions;

- Go to the user you wish to report.
- Tap on 
- Tap on **Report** & then **Report Inappropriate**.
- Then select why you are reporting.
